Long Buckby Preschool Co-op Community Fund

Long Buckby Preschool has been chosen by the Co-op for it's latest round of the community fund. This started at the end of October and lasts for the whole year. We would love you to make us your selection for your co-op points.

Long Buckby Preschool are a registered charity and a non profit making setting providing childcare for children aged 2-4 years in the local community. We aim to provide good quality childcare for all children whatever their background or educational needs. We promote a diverse range of learning and development activities offering our children a good variety enabling them to be ready for their next step to school. Our Preschool is lead by a voluntary parent committee who oversee the running of our setting and raise additional money to enhance the environment and experience of our children. The last major project was to provide a canopy to cover the outside area to allow our children to make the most of our outdoor space.

The next project we are planning is to update and enhance our facilities, including an all-weather surface and play equipment for our outdoor learning area. Outdoor learning is beneficial to all our children and allows us to introduce letters and numbers in a fun creative way. The all weather surface would mean in the winter months the children would not be restricted to a small dry area under the canopy. They can then make more use of the equipment such as balance bikes all year round.

ABSENCE PROCEDURE

If your child is off school please ring the office before 9 am to confirm your child's absence from school detailing the reason why.

The registers will be checked by 9:30 am and if a child is absent and contact has not been received we will contact parents via order of priority contact, logging each number tried and the result, to determine that the child is absent and that the parent/carer knows where and who they are with. Should the school be unable



to get a reply on any of the numbers we will repeat the process until 11.00 am when a decision will be taken whether to undertake a home visit to check on the child's welfare.

As we approach the winter season it is quite likely that your child may become ill with coughs, colds or sickness bugs. Please see be-

If your child has been sick or has diarrhoea your child will have to stay off school for 48 hours to prevent the spread of the bug.
