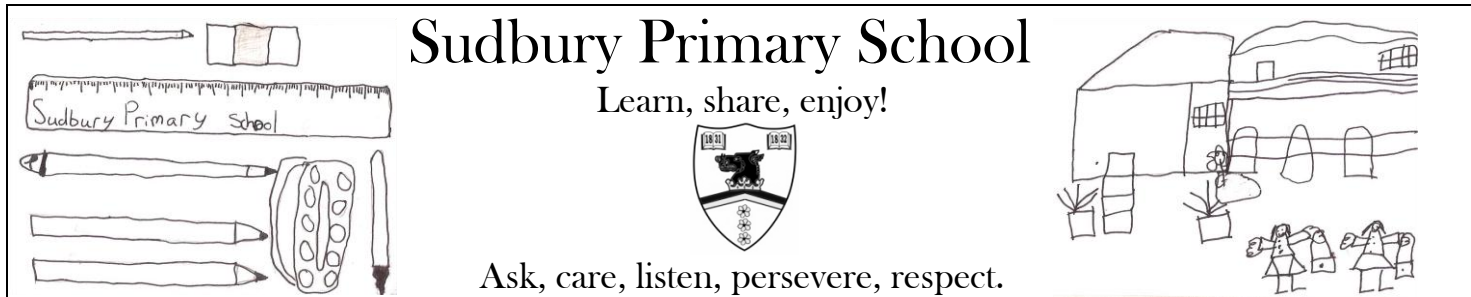
Class Two Kingswood Residential Trip
