## **Mrs Barnes**

Next week in maths Year 1 will be learning to describe position and direction using common words (including half turns); compare lengths and heights; estimate, compare and measure lengths using uniform non-standard and standard units. Reception will be counting and recognising numbers to 20 and begin to chant numbers to 100.

In English the children will identify and describe the main characters from Toy Story and use adjectives to describe a new character.

We are practising letter sounds with Reception every day in school and some good progress is being made. Thank you for your hard work at home and continue as it really does make a difference to their learning. Please record in their reading record books when you practise with them and add comments.
