This framework has been written to model linear teaching of AT 1. It also includes opportunities for assessment of AT 2 (i) and (ii). Block 1 provides content for Levels 1 to 3; Block 2 for Levels 3-5 Completion of a 'levelled' activity does not automatically constitute achievement of that level and that both ongoing and summative assessment should be used to judge the levels at which pupils are working.

Pupils will learn about:

Revelation: (7-11)

- The Bible
- The Gospel accounts of key events in the life of Jesus: the Nativity. (7-11)
- God's call to people in the Old Testament

The Church (7-11)

- The role of Mary as Mother of Jesus

Celebration (7-11)

- The Church's celebrations of significant events in the life of Jesus (7-11)
- Community prayer

How do we remember and wait for the birth of Jesus? AT 1 (ii)**

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- a. Recognise, describe or give reasons for some of the symbols, actions and words associated with Advent (AT 1 (ii) Levels 1-3)
- b. Prepare a Liturgy of the Word (AT 1 (ii) Level 4)

How does the Gospel of Luke record the birth of Jesus? AT 1 (i)

- c. Retell Luke's account of the birth of Jesus (AT 1 (i) Level 2)
- d. Examine Luke's account of the birth of Jesus and identify expression of belief in the incarnation (AT 1 (i) Level 3)

How does the local community celebrate the birth of Jesus today? AT 1 (iii)

- e. Make links between two sources: the incarnation in Scripture and in the celebration of Christmas today (AT 1 (i) Level 4)
- f. Recognise, describe or explain that people act in particular ways because of their faith (AT 1 (iii) Levels 1-3)
- g. Explain how religious belief shapes life (AT 1 (iii) Level 4)

Spiritual Outcomes:

It is hoped that pupils will develop:

- A sense of wonder about the coming of God into the world
- A disposition of prayer
- An openness to the mystery of God, incarnate
- An appreciation of the gift of Christmas
