Here is the log from our historical school log book for November 11th 1918

"During this time the school was closed. The European War which has raged since August 4th 1914 came to a close this morning, by terms of an armistice which the German representatives signed. Peace will be declared later. Wide world public rejoicings."

November 13th 1918

"School opened again this morning, about one third of children absent. Registered marked."
