Dear Parents and Carers,

On Thursday 6th December 2018, Year 6 students will be visiting Rochester Cathedral. The purpose of this visit is for the children to have the opportunity to perform Christmas Carols, which they will learn in school, alongside other local schools.

The cost of this event will be £1.58 per child. This is payable through Parent Pay before Friday 23rd November.

The children will need to be dropped off at the Guildhall Museum in Rochester at 10:15am on Thursday 6th December and then picked up from the same location at 3:15pm.

The children will need to bring a packed lunch with them for the day in a plastic carrier bag that can be thrown away. If your child is entitled to a free school meal, The Contract Dining Company will provide this.

Each child will receive one ticket for a parent or carer to come and watch the performance of carols at the Cathedral, from 14:00pm-15:00pm. Unfortunately, there are no additional tickets available. The Cathedral have asked us to inform you that there is the chance you may not be able to see your child singing due to the layout of the building.

We would also like to bring to your attention that press photographers will be invited to attend one of the dress rehearsals and Rochester Cathedral will be taking publicity photos. If you do not wish your child to be photographed at the concert, please can you advise our office staff by email no later than Friday 30th November.
