

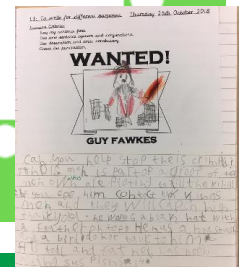
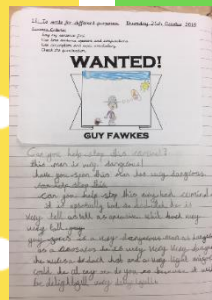
Reading
