**Welcome Back:** I hope that you all had a great break and are looking forward to the learning that is ahead in Term 2! The Curriculum Letter will be coming out on Monday for you to see what we will be covering this term.

**5 times table:** This term I would like you to learn the 5 times table, a copy of it will be sent home with this letter. Please ensure you are still practising the ten times table alongside the five times table as you will be tested on both. Learn the number sentence with the answer and both ways ( $5 \times 1 = 5$  and  $1 \times 5 = 5$ ).

**High frequency words:** By the end of year 2 there are a number of words the children should be spelling correctly that are called high frequency words. Not all of these can be spelt phonetically so the spellings have to be learnt over time. I have sent a home a copy of these words as it would be useful for children to practice these throughout the year at home. I appreciate your support with this. If you lose the sheet please ask me for another.

**English:** Please write a sentence for at least 3 of your spellings in your homework book (that should be at least 3 sentences in total).

**Remember:** joined writing (if you can), capital letters and full stops.

**Challenge:** Try to extend your sentences using **and**, **but**, **so** or **because**. Feel free to do more than 3 sentences if you have time.

**Reading:** Please remember to try to read **every day** for 10 minutes. At some point each week please ask an adult to write a small comment in your reading log to let me know how you are getting on at home.

**Spellings:** The spelling test will be on Wednesday.

Grasshoppers: the **igh** sound spelt **y**.

Remember the rhyme: If the end of a word sounds like **igh**, it is almost always spelt with a **y**. Please try and learn all the spellings.
