

## Pupil Premium 2017/18

Pupil Premium is additional money given to the school to support pupils who are considered disadvantaged. The chosen measure for this allocation is the entitlement to Free School Meals within the past six years. The funding for 2017/18 is £1,320 per pupil; £36,960 in total for our school.

The table below shows the range of activities on which the money was spent and the impact of this expenditure.
