Prime Areas

The children have been learning all about Diwali and why this is celebrated. The children have made Diya lamps using clay and decorated with paint and jewels.

In PE, the children have been moving like fire-works. They have moved to music and used

different parts of the body to move on.

In communication and language, the children have been talking about keeping safe around fireworks and making loud fireworks noises outside.

Specific Areas

In literacy, the children have been learning all about Bonfire night and Guy Fawkes. We have discussed why we celebrate this and how. Also we have read stories about keeping safe around fireworks.

In phonics, the children are learning Phase 2 sounds. We recapped sounds learnt so far:

s, a, t, p, i, n, m, d, g, o, c, k, ck

e, u, r and introduced four new sounds:

h, b, f, ll, ss and thought of words using these sounds.

In maths the children have been learning about 1 less and 1 more using a number line to show this up to 20.
