As we have recently had our summer outcomes confirmed, we are very pleased to inform you that the school has performed exceptionally well in the 2018 Key Stage Two end of year assessments. At Sunny Bank 97% of our children met the expected standard in Reading, Writing and Maths.

100% of our children met the expected standard in Reading, 97% of our children met the expected standard in Writing, 100% of our children met the expected standard in Maths, 100% of our children met the expected standard in GPS and 100% of our children met the expected standard in Science. This places Sunny Bank as one of the best performing primary school in Bury Local Authority.

We are very proud of all the hard work that last year's Year Six children put in alongside the dedication and hard work from all the staff in school. These outcomes reflect the quality of education on offer at Sunny Bank Primary School.
