This week the children have had lots of fun adding colours and textures to their animal junk models. Please pop in and the children can show you the work they have done so far.

We have been counting objects in maths this week. We have been learning to line objects up and count them carefully to make sure our counting is accurate.

The children enjoyed recording hopes for themselves and others by the candlelight of the Diya lamps on their tables.
