WW1 Centenary

On **Friday, 9th November**, the children are encouraged to dress up as an historical hero, for example a soldier or Florence Nightingale, to celebrate 100 years since WW1 for a donation of £1 which will be donated to the Help for Hero's charity. We are also selling poppies and other associated items i.e. rulers and keyrings in aid of Remembrance Day. These items can be purchased in Breakfast Club or during the afternoon in school. Should your child wish to purchase any items please send the money to school. The items range from 50p to £1 each, again any money will be going to the Help for Hero's charity. We have decided to create our own poppy wall and therefore all year groups will be making a poppy out of different materials. Year 3 pupils will be making poppies out of plastic bottles and therefore we are asking for any donations in order for them to do so.
