There are currently 25 out of 29 children (86%) in our Year 6 cohort who are meeting the national curriculum requirement to swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres, 86% use a range of strokes effectively and 86% perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations.
