After exploring the different types of African art, we focussed on Edward Tingatinga and created our own version of his art work.



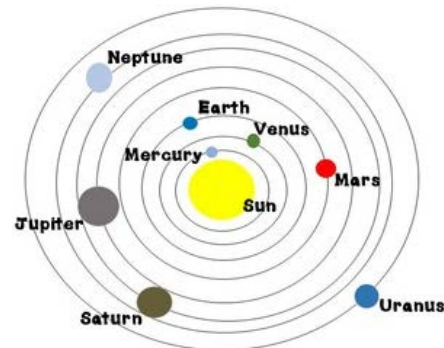
Divali – November 2018
