### Literacy

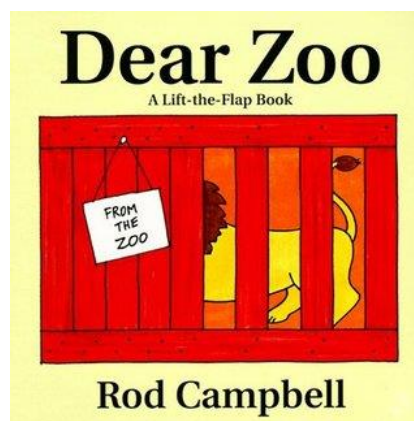
This week in Literacy we have been thinking about sounds. The younger children have been thinking about quiet and loud sounds and have had a go at making different sounds with the musical instruments. The older children have been starting to think about the initial sounds in words. They have sorted objects into those beginning with 's' and those beginning with 'd'. The sound of the week has been the letter 'd'.

### Maths

In Maths this week the children have continued to look at 2D shapes, including squares, circles, rectangles and triangles. They have thought about the names of the shapes and how they could describe them. For example, a rectangle looks like a door and a window looks like a square. They have drawn around plastic shapes in their workbooks and sorted them into the different types.

### Topic

This week we have added a new 'Potions Lab' to the role play area. The children have been mixing ingredients using a variety of resources and have had great fun feeding their concoctions to myself, Miss Benham and each other. We have also been studying the story **Dear Zoo** by **Rod Campbell**. The children have been practising saying the story and using Makaton signs for the different characters. They have thought about which animal they would ask for and written a letter to the zoo asking them to send it.
