As the school was oversubscribed the governors' oversubscription criteria were applied. The preferences were ranked according to criteria. Within each category, special cases with supporting evidence were given priority followed by distance.

Foundation Places: Children were offered a place under criteria 2 – 11. There were no places allocated on the basis of a special case.

Community Places: Children were offered a place under criteria 12 and 13. One of the 17 children allocated a place in Category 13 had a special case for attending St Andrew's. The furthest child offered a place under criteria 13 lives 538.34m from the school (853.85m in 2017).
