Dear Parents and Guardians

We would like to take the children in Year 1 to the Carriageworks Theatre in Leeds for a morning performance of Beauty and the Beast. The trip will take place on Tuesday 4 December 2018. The children will come to school earlier at 8.45am, wearing school uniform. They will all have a packed lunch back at school in the afternoon. The children will be collected from school as usual at 3.15pm.

A packed lunch and drink will be required. Our school cook, Mrs Melling, can provide a packed lunch comprising of the following: -

Sandwich Fillings - Egg, Tuna or Cheese Homemade Biscuit/Bun AND Piece of Fruit AND A Drink

Key Stage One children are **entitled** to a free school meal and therefore are **entitled** to a free packed lunch. If you wish school to provide a packed lunch, you **must order in advance** on the attached consent form. If your child is bringing a **packed lunch from home it will need to be in a named carrier bag, including a drink in a disposable carton, NO FIZZY DRINKS.**


In order to make this visit possible we require a voluntary payment of £18.00. This is to cover the cost of the venue, the coach and insurance. If we do not receive sufficient payments we will be unable to go ahead with the visit. Please send in the consent form and the payment by Tuesday 27 November.

As always on a trip we do need a small number of parent helpers. If you would like to come for the morning please sign the relevant part of the slip. As this is a popular trip we will choose helpers out of a hat. Please note once you have committed to help it causes us a lot of complications if you let us down on the day.

In case of emergency, it is necessary for the Group Leader to have your consent to authorise medical treatment. This would only be used if it was deemed necessary and provided that the delay needed to obtain your signature might be considered in the opinion of a doctor or surgeon, likely to endanger the child's health and safety. Obviously, in the event of an emergency every effort would be made to contact you first.
