

## Maths



We will be focussing on:

- Naming and describing 2D shapes
- Naming and describing 3D shapes
- Multiplication as repeated addition and as an array
- Solving multiplication word problems
- Division as sharing

## Religious Education



The children will learn about celebrations in different religions. They will also learn about the Christmas Story and participate in our Christmas Performance of 'The Magical Christmas Jigsaw.' They will attend Christingle and Carol services at the church.

## Literacy

The children will look at poetry and write a variety of poems based on our topic. They will also each learn a poem to perform to their peers. We will also be looking at the features of non-fiction writing and creating their own non-chronological reports. SPaG learning will include learning about and identifying the four types of sentences: statements, questions, exclamations and commands. We will learn about adverbs to describe movements of fireworks.

## History

The children will learn about Guy Fawkes and the events of The Gunpowder Plot.

They will also learn about Remembrance Day and research soldiers from Hove. They will sequence events in the Remembrance Sunday Service and reflect on the role of service men and women.




## Geography

The children will name and locate the four countries and capital cities of the UK and the surrounding seas. They will use basic geographical vocabulary to refer to human and physical features in our local area.



## Computing

## Music



The children will be learning about rhythm, beat and timbre. They will explore the timbre of different percussion instruments and use them to perform simple rhythm.

## PSHE and SEAL
