- Count in 2s, 3s, 5s & 10s
- Place value (T/O)
- Identify, represent & estimate numbers
- Compare/ order numbers, using <, > and =
- Write numbers to 100 in numerals and words
- Know number facts to 10/20
- Show how addition can be done in any order.
- Add and subtract numbers and solve word problems

Religious Education

The children will be learning about the story of 'Creation'. They will learn about how Christians believe that God created the earth. We will discuss the importance of everything on earth and learn how we can protect the environment.



Literacy

Key Texts - The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch and The Snail and the Whale. Ideas from these texts will be used to teach story sequencing, character profiles, diary writing and report writing.

SPaG learning will include using expanded noun phrases (adjectives), verbs (present/past tenses), the four different types of sentences and vowels and consonants.



History

The children will find out about seaside holidays in the past. We will look at the clothes, food, transport and entertainment during these times. The children will watch a live Punch and Judy show and will be able to handle the puppets.

Year 2 Autumn Term 1



Geography

The children will name and locate the four countries and capital cities of the UK and the surrounding seas. They will use basic geographical vocabulary to refer to human and physical features in our local area.



Computing



The children will learn about e-Safety and use technology respectfully, keeping personal information private. They will make simple presentations and create pictures using Dazzle.

Science

We will learn about animals including humans and that all animals reproduce. The children will learn about the basic needs for survival: water, food and air. They will be taught about the importance of exercise, eating a healthy balanced diet and about the need for good hygiene.



Music



The children will be learning about rhythm and beat. We will perform and understand the difference between rhythm and pulse. We will learn to read simple rhythms patterns using 'tea' and 'coffee' to represent crotchet and quavers.

PSHE and SEAL



This term focuses on New Beginnings. Children will have opportunities to appreciate and celebrate differences and similarities between themselves and to experience how supportive it feels to belong to, and be valued by, the class group.

DT

We will design, make and evaluate a hand puppet using a variety of materials.



Art

The children will make a seaside collage using different techniques. They will look at The Big Wave by Katsushika Hokusai and will use different graded pencils for observational drawings.



P.E.

In gymnastics we will be focussing on shape and balance. We will also focus on mastering basic skills such as running, jumping, throwing and begin to apply these to a range of activities including team games.
