

Humanities

Year 6 will, over a series of sessions, explore 4 and 6-figure grid references, symbols and keys (including the use of Ordnance Survey maps) to build their knowledge of the United Kingdom and the wider world. In History we will be studying WW2 and, in particular, the way it impacted on children and evacuees.



Religious Education

The children will explore the significance of art in various religions and will then move on to look at the importance of Christmas in the Christian calendar.




Extra info

Year 6 will create a musical composition through a study of rhythm, beat and tempo.




Art and Design

Year 6 will use their sketch books to gather ideas about mythical beasts and creatures; they will design their own version using mixed media techniques. They will also be looking at how to create movement art using a variety of line, texture and colour.




Science

In Science this term we will be studying the differences and similarities between plants and animals and their life cycles. We will also be studying how micro-organisms effect our daily lives in both positive and negative ways.



English

Our main focus text is *The Lion, The Witch and The Wardrobe* and most of our work is based around this wonderful story where we produce written pieces within a range of styles and genres. There is also a heavy emphasis in Year 6 on reading (and comprehension), spelling, and the children knowing specific grammatical terminology; this is embedded within their work and taught alongside the writing but also in discreet, focused sessions.



Computing

This term, the children will learn how to keep safe online through an e-safety scheme of work. This will prepare them for the challenges they may face in the future. They will also use a variety of multimedia software to present information.

PE



For PE we will be focusing on indoor cricket and outdoor invasion games.

Indoor PE: the children will help to choreograph and perform a dance in small groups and as a class with a visiting dance specialist.

Maths



Maths will be taught discretely with links to the topic where appropriate. The children will also experience investigations and activities designed to develop their logical-thinking skills.

The first term particularly focuses on number fluency and arithmetic techniques, including the four written methods and work on fractions, decimals and percentages.
