

One Week topic w/b 5.11.18

English

- Collect adjectives, nouns, verbs and adverbs about fireworks and display on working wall.
- Firework spine poem. Create a class poem using coloured strips of paper to match nouns, adjectives, verbs and adverbs on working wall. E.g.

Colourful

rockets

soaring

wildly

- Children to write independent spine poems using smaller strips of paper.
- Encourage use of strategies taught in spelling, including spelling chart and 'have a go' strategy.
- Diary hot write in role as Guy Fawkes (at end of week once information has been taught).

Guided reading

Daily reading sessions

- Cross curricular opportunities- Fireworks/ Guy Fawkes reading comprehension.

RE & PSHE

- Firework safety (Horrible Histories firework safety with Guy Fawkes)
- Develop an understanding of the Protestant and Catholic element of the story of Guy Fawkes.

The Gunpowder Plot

Computing

- Children to film each other telling the story of the Gunpowder Plot. This can be through the children acting or the use of puppets.



History

By the end of the week children will:

- be able to sequence the events of the gunpowder plot (through drama).
- Explain why people celebrate firework/bonfire/Guy Fawkes night, showing some understanding that different people celebrate the event for different reasons.
- Understand the vocabulary '*parliament*'.
- Demonstrate a beginning understanding of the historical concepts 'cause' and 'consequence'.

- Explore a range of techniques and media to create firework pictures.
