LEARNING CHALLENGE: WHO ARE YOUR FAVOURITE STORY CHARACTERS?

Expressive Arts & Design

This half term we will continue to look at small world activities and to work on using colours. We will be looking at using different media within our art work and look at designing and evaluating our work. .

Understanding the World

This half term we will be learning all about things that live under the sea. We will be describing plants and animals and looking at the differences between animals. As this half term approaches Christmas we will also be looking at the Nativity and learning all about the birth of Jesus.

Literacy

We will be learning sounds this half term and building upon our previous work of blending and segmenting to ensure we can write a read simple words. We will also be looking at words that we can't sound out which are 'tricky words' .

Mathematics

We will be continuing to look at our numbers and learning more of them this half term. We will be looking at one more and one less of a given number and also looking at some simple practical addition. We will be looking at shape and measure.

Physical Development

We will be continuing to explore moving in different ways and looking at Healthy Eating. We will be continuing to improve our motor skills and then use them to help us form our letters cursively as we begin to learn our new sounds.

Personal, Social & Emotional Development

We will be continuing our work on following the routines of our school and introducing children to some new routines. We will continue our work on working with others and also be looking at being confident to talk about our own wants, needs and opinions.

Communication & Language

We will continue to work on our Listening & Attention skills by playing a variety of different games. We will be continuing to improve our vocabulary and use our speech when playing with our friends. We will be exploring our P4C skills to help us with this.
