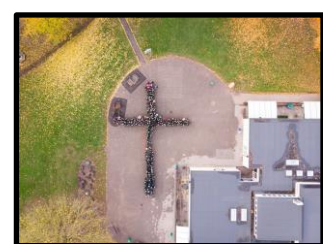
## This week at Walsgrave...
