A Visit From OFSTED

As you are aware, we were visited by an OFSTED inspector this week who carried out a one-day inspection of the school. As a good school, we were given a short inspection.

A school judged to be good at its last inspection normally receives a one-day short inspection approximately every four years. The purpose of a short inspection is to determine whether the school continues to provide a good standard of education and whether safeguarding is effective.

She visited all of the classrooms during the day, including the new nursery, and looked at many books and displays. She spoke to lots of children and members of staff, and had conversations with parents on the playground too.

The outcome of the inspection is confidential at the moment. We cannot share any of the findings of the inspection until the report is published, which will be in approximately three weeks. We will, of course, share this report with you as soon as it is made available to us. We would like to thank all the parents who spoke to the inspector in the morning and those who completed the online survey too. The inspection was a very rigorous process, but a positive one; it gave us the opportunity to talk about all the lovely things we do at Forest Glade.
