Dear Parents,
Welcome to this week's newsletter.

The school has seen some very brightly dressed children today in their Children in Need Tag Day clothes. We managed to raise £111.10 toward this very worthy charity. Thank you all for your donations.

Last week we raised £1,784 for the British Legion Poppy Appeal and this total will rise even higher when the gift aid is added, so well done to all! I think you will all agree this is an absolutely staggering amount raised!

We are eagerly anticipating our Fireworks Display this evening. Gates open at 6.p.m. The entrance will be by the large gates leading directly onto the field on 'The Street'. Could I remind you that parking is not available at the village hall, however we are allowed to use the field behind The Bell. Alternatively, the commuter car park at the end of the village has plenty of spaces.

There will be small items for sale e.g. light wands etc. before the Display, which will commence at 7.p.m. We will also have drinks, hot dogs and soup for sale. Make sure you wrap up warmly and don't forget your wristbands for entry!! No dogs or sparklers allowed.

Decorations have been on sale after school on the front playground for 50p each. For the new parents; the children colour these and then apply a coat of clear nail varnish to them. They bring them back into school on Friday 30th November for our advent event, where the school join together on the front playground and sing carols around the Christmas Tree which was kindly donated by J.W Farms the Butchers, in Fairview Avenue.

Each child then hangs their decoration on the tree. Parents are welcome to join us and join in with the singing. We will begin this event at 2.30p.m.
