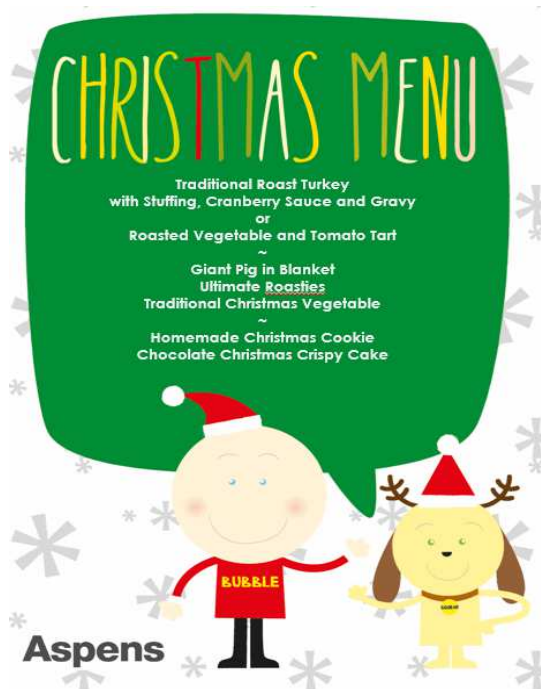

A volunteer who does not work with children for a period of 3 months or more must be rechecked if they subsequently start working with children again. Therefore please can we ask that for any parent who already has an active DBS check in place to 'volunteer' in school at least once a term so that we can adhere to these guidelines and keep the DBS active. If you are unsure whether your DBS is active or not please ask at the school office.
