

This Week


With Mrs James the children focused on rhyming words. They described the sounds that fireworks make and then found real words that rhymed with them. On Wednesday they then used these words in sentences to make a funny firework poem.

Maths has been about 3D shapes. The class were eager to share what they had learned with Mrs Dunk on her return. Towards the end of the week we began to draw around the 3D shapes to see what 2D faces they had. We have described 3D shapes as solids you can hold and 2D shapes as flat as a piece of paper, you couldn't put anything in them.

Year 1 have had a lot of discussion around bullying in PSHE this week due to it being Anti-Bullying week. The children have discussed how we all have things that are the same and different about us and we should respect those things rather than make fun of them. We have also emphasised the point that bullying is a behaviour that is consistently repeated with intent to cause harm so they know the difference between someone being unkind and a bully.
