Y3 Stone Age Workshop

Over the Autumn term, we have been learning about the Stone Age through to the Iron Age. We have explored how people survived in the Stone Age, created our own roundhouses and investigated the discovery of Skara Brae along with much more.

As part of this unit, we have arranged for a visitor to come into Year 3 on Thursday 6th December for a Stone Age workshop. The workshop will be all day with the normal break for lunch. Children will participate in digging for artefacts and discussing what they have found, hunting and gathering for food using a range of replica Stone Age tools and will be able to handle rare and expensive artefacts not normally seen in day-to-day school life.

It is necessary to ask you to make a voluntary contribution of £8.30 for the workshop by Monday 26th November at the latest.

In line with all other schools in Havering and across the UK, we have to stipulate that contributions towards trips/workshops are on a voluntary basis. However, should contributions meet less than 90% of the cost of running a single trip; the trip/workshop will be cancelled as the school cannot be expected to meet these costs.
