Please see below our school notices for this week:-

- **Year 4 are going on a trip to Butser Farm on Monday 19th November.** Children need to be at school at 8.00am and we expect them to return by 4.30pm. Please can children come dressed in clothes appropriate for the weather conditions and be aware that they may well get muddy. They also need a snack, a water bottle and a packed lunch (no nuts please) and a maximum of £5 to spend in the gift shop.
- There is a **Reading and Phonics meeting for parents and carers of Reception and Year 1 children** who have English as a second language. This will take place on Wednesday 21st November at 9am in the small hall. Coffee will be served from 8.45am.
