Explanations- *Can I use causal connectives to write a simple explanation?*

- Teach the spoken explanation of the Great Fire of London using symbols and actions.
- Children read the written version of this text.
- Identify causal connectives within text.
- Look at a good example of an explanation versus a not so good one. Which works well and why?
- Show pictures linked to Great Fire and model explaining using causal connective. Children practise explaining pictures verbally using causal connectives.
- Teach layout-Heading, introduction, words and pictures, finish.
- Shared write an explanation to go with a picture.
- Children write their own explanations.
