# Digging Deep!

In Maths the children will:

- Discover the different types of rocks and how they are formed.
- Children will compare and group rocks based on appearance and simple properties.
- They will learn how fossils are formed and learn about the contribution of Mary Anning to the field of palaeontology.
- Children will understand how soil is formed and then investigate the permeability of different types of soil.
