Literacy

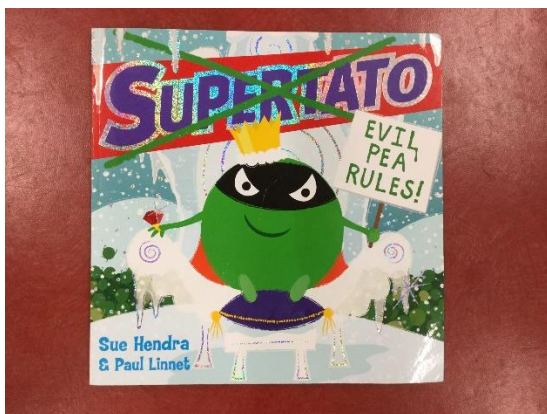
