This Sunday is the feast of Christ the King. But Jesus didn't live in a palace or wear a gold crown.

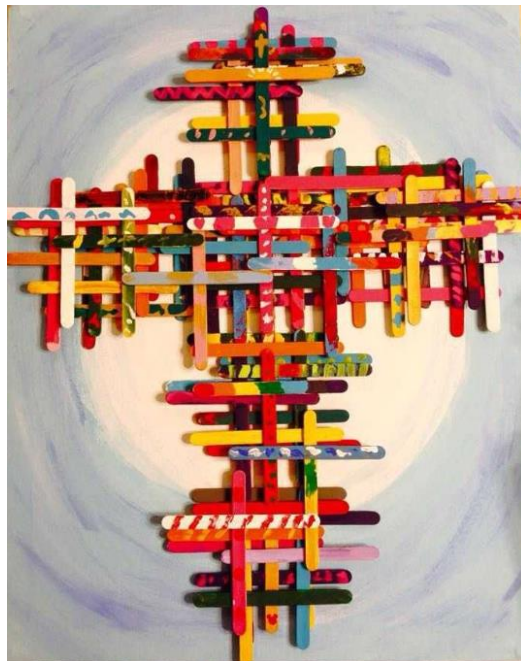
