

## Sports Premium Overview September 2017 to August 2018

### Warmsworth Primary School:

At Warmsworth Primary School we believe PE and Sport plays an integral role in and has the potential to change young people's lives for the better. We recognise that PE plays an important role in the health and wellbeing of children and the positive impact PE and extra-curricular activities can have on the attitudes, confidence and academic achievement of all our children.

We have been committed to using the Sports Premium funding to improve our provision of Physical Education and sport throughout our school.

### Sports Premium Grant:

The government provides funding jointly provided by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport, to see money going directly to primary schools to spend on improving the quality of sport and PE for all their children. All schools with 17 or more primary aged pupils will receive a lump sum of £16,000 plus a premium of £10.00 per pupil.

### What does the Sports Premium mean for my school?

'Schools must spend the additional funding on improving their provision of PE and sport, but they will have the freedom to choose how they do this.'

At school we have split up the funding by three key areas for consideration; Physical Education, Healthy Active Lifestyles and Competitive sport. We have decided to spend the Sports Premium Grant on:

**Physical Education: To improve the quality of Teaching and Learning in physical Education**

Objective	Projected Outcomes
<p>To ensure all children have access to high quality PE teaching across the curriculum.</p> <p><b>Actions:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Employ specialist PE coach (JHSC) to work alongside teachers and deliver after-school clubs.</li> <li>• Organisation of playtime sports activities by specialist coach.</li> <li>• PE coordinator providing support for members of staff within our school to up level their skills by either going on courses or working alongside them within PE lessons.</li> </ul> <p><b>Amount: £11966.17</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Children to learn a variety of sports ranging from Netball, Boccia and Tag Rugby.</li> <li>• Children to have opportunities to acquire basic skills of these sports as well as participate in competitive elements of these games.</li> <li>• Provide children with the skills and passion to embrace sporting opportunities in the wider community.</li> </ul>

**Healthy Active Lifestyles: Ensuring all our children have access to regular exercise**

Objective	Projected Outcomes
<p>To increase fitness levels of all children.</p> <p><b>Actions:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Promote PE activities during KS2 assembly on Tuesdays.</li> <li>• Termly fitness tests using bleep tests to monitor effectiveness of fitness levels acquired.</li> <li>• Intensive and extended warm ups during outdoor and indoor PE sessions.</li> <li>• School clubs set up to encourage target groups to participate in and enjoy more physical activities.</li> </ul> <p><b>Amount: £3700.00</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Improved behaviour in the playground/lesson times.</li> <li>• Positive attitudes towards health and well-being.</li> <li>• Data analysis shows increased fitness levels.</li> </ul>

**Competitive School Sport: Increasing pupil's participation in extra-curricular sport and competitions**

<p>To sustain/increase participation in competitions and to increase our role in organising and supporting sport in the district.</p> <p>To maintain the Sainsbury's School Games Mark Gold award.</p> <p>To increase the percentage of children participating in extra-curricular clubs.</p> <p><b>Actions:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Compete in a full range of pyramid events calendar events.</li> <li>• Increase number of places for children to access after-school clubs.</li> <li>• Opportunities to enter and compete in Sir Thomas Wharton Pyramid and other pyramid competitions.</li> <li>• Engage in Doncaster sporting events and South Yorkshire competitions.</li> <li>• Work with Doncaster School Games Organiser-Craig Dallas</li> </ul> <p><b>Amount: £3893.83</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Children have the opportunity to compete in a wider range of competitions.</li> <li>• Compete in Active Fusion school competition calendar.</li> <li>• 20% increase in children attending after-school clubs.</li> <li>• Compete in competitions linked with Doncaster Rovers.</li> <li>• Active links with sports clubs in the community.</li> </ul>
