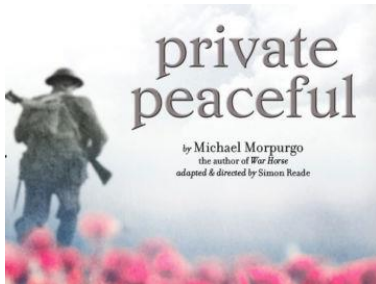
If you would like to bring in a donation for the food bank, these are the items that are currently urgently needed:
