

Personal, Social and Emotional and RE

We will be focussing on **Keeping Safe** in PSHE and in RE will continue to look at Special Places.

Computing

In Computing we will be focussing on Computer Skills. The children will learn the basic computer skills that they will need in order to be able to use a desktop or laptop computer.

Mathematics

Number- Addition and Subtraction (Within 10)

- Represent and use number bonds and related subtraction facts within 10
- Read, write and interpret mathematical statements involving addition (+), subtraction (-) and equals (=) signs.
- Add and subtract one

Geometry: Shape

- Recognise and name common 2-D shapes, including: (for example, rectangles (including squares), circles and triangles)
- Recognise and name common 3-D shapes including: (for example, cuboids (including cubes), pyramids and spheres)

Home Learning- Year 1 only will continue to bring home a Maths Game weekly, these will be changed on Mondays.

English/Literacy

Our English work this term will focus on the text:

Wilfred Gordon McDonald Partridge

Our main outcome will be to write additional sentences for the story. *When Miss Nancy remembers....* We will be focussing on what is a sentence.

Super Sentences- Every day, we have Super Sentences! We all grab a whiteboard and a pen and have a go at writing the words or sentences. We must all have a go at the **green words**, should all try the **orange words** and could have a go at the **red words** for a real challenge! To begin with we are copying - giving us lots of time to focus on handwriting, capital letters, finger spaces and punctuation. Eventually we will move onto completing sentences with our own words/ideas!

Home Learning- All Wagtails are to practise their letters and sounds/tricky words and read their reading books daily. They will be rewarded for reading 10 times at home.

Understanding of the World

We will be: *Finding out about some of the key events and people involved in the Gunpowder Plot. Finding out why the Gunpowder Plot happened. And sequencing the main events of the Gunpowder Plot.*

Children will be reflecting on their memories and beginning to understand the meaning of symbols, in particular the Remembrance Day poppy. We will be exploring and discovering the reasons behind Remembrance Day and how the event is marked around the world.
