Dear Parents and Carers,

Re: Reception Outing

As part of our learning this half term, we have planned for each class to take a short walk in the local environment and for each child to post a letter they have written. Whilst we are 'out and about' we will also be encouraging children to look for, talk about and develop their understanding of environmental features such as shapes and patterns. We ask that you ensure your child has a warm, waterproof coat with them.

Wren class' outing will be on Monday 3rd December.
Owl class' outing will be on Tuesday 4th December.
Robin class' outing will be on Wednesday 5th December.
Sparrow class' outing will be on Thursday 6th December.

The children will come to school in the morning as normal. We will aim to leave by 9.15am. Each class will be accompanied by members of school staff and parent helpers. We will walk to South Ealing Road Post Office to post the letters in the post box outside. We will return to school by approximately 10.15am.

The money for the stamps will be taken from the voluntary donations we have collected. If you haven't already done so and you are able to, please bring your donation to the EYFS Office. (We suggest £5 for the term, or £15 for the year.)

We will send consent forms home with the children today. Please return the completed form to your child's class teacher by Tuesday 27th November. If you are able to volunteer to help, please also indicate this on the form. Each class will need at least 4 parent helpers. If you do not have a DBS which has been checked by the school, you will need to fill in a Trip Volunteer Request form from the EYFS Office. In the event that too many parents volunteer to help, names will be drawn out of a hat.

There will be other trips during the school year which require parents and carers to have DBS certificates. If you are interested and would be able to help in the future, please complete a DBS application form, which can also be obtained from the EYFS office.
