## Foundation

Last week, during Say No to Bullying Week, we had lots of discussions about what bullying is, what to do if we are bullied or see bullying happening and how we can prevent it in our school. We thought about kindness; talking about why it is important and ways in which we can be kind to each other. The children then came up with some of their own anti-bullying messages.




This week we have been thinking about Superheroes. We have been rescuing bears from Super Villains in maths, untying superheroes in the finger gym, designing our own superhero costumes, making masks and perfecting our superhero moves in PE.



## Class 1 & 2

This week we have started to look at our new text Into the Forest by Anthony Browne. So far, we have only looked at the front cover and the first page. We have been looking for clues in the illustrations and predicting what the story might be about.



In maths, we have been looking at addition and practicing combining two sets to find the total and using + and = to write a number sentence. We also used our number skills in Science this week when we used counting to investigate whether the children with the biggest feet also had the biggest hands (We found out that they didn't!)

It has been Road Safety week and our class have made posters to remind people of the best way to cross a road. We have used the words Stop, Look, Listen and Think to help us to stay safe. In a few weeks we will put our safety skills to the test when the Calderdale Road Safety team come to visit.



We have continued to practice our dances in PE, we have been looking at making different shapes, some of us even tried making letters with different parts of our bodies!



## Class 3

Class 3 finished our story Oh No, George! story last week by using small world figure to retell the story. We really enjoyed this and used some great story language in our play.



This week we have been sharing the story Goldilocks and the Three Bears. We have made and tried porridge, we didn't all like it!

We have also been investigating 3D shapes. We went on a shape walk to find objects in the environment that were cylindrical, cubes, cuboids, etc. We did fantastic looking and some of us even earned a Head Teacher's Award.

In motor skills this term we are working developing on our throwing and catching skills.
