Dear Parents/ Guardians,

In the basket this week we discovered three little chairs and three little beds, the children realised we must be going to read the story 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears'. We created a class story map (pictures drawn in a sequence to represent the story) which the children loved. We thought about the story language used in traditional tales and some of the children went on to create their own story maps. In Maths we discovered a bear and a human footprint which lead to a discussion about who they could belong to. We compared our footprints to see if the mysterious print could belong to one of us. Then we measured them using cubes to see whose was the longest. Our job of the week was to order bears according to length (shortest to longest) and some children went on to do their own measuring using cubes.

In PE we used some of the apparatus to climb on, around, over and under and in music we learnt two new 'Three Bears' songs.

Next week we will be looking at real bears and talking about some of the differences between them and where they live. Please could you help your child to find a bear fact for them to bring in on Monday to share with the class.

As the weather starts to grow cold please could you be aware that we spend a lot of time outside and the children will need a named hat, scarf and gloves.
