Dear Parents/ Guardians,

This week we have completed our work on 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears' by finding out lots of information on the different bears which live around the world. We compiled a big fact page and the children enjoyed sharing their fact. Thank you to those of you who were able to find something out about bears and sharing these with your child.

In maths we have focussed on number as most of the children are very good at recognising numerals to 10 but are finding numerals to 20 more tricky. We have also focussed on recording numerals with correct formation.

In phonics we are beginning to apply our understanding of the sounds to recording words using the correct letters. One of the activities that we do is 'quick write' where we say the phoneme and the children have to record the phoneme without seeing it. Some of the children have said that they have been practising letter formation at home so we are attaching a letter formation sheet to help you to know how we are teaching the children to form the letters in school. We find these useful to laminate and use with a white board pen.
