Why is punctuality so important?

It is important to be in school on time as punctuality is linked with good attendance and forms good habits for your child's future. If your child misses the start of the school day, they will miss work and vital time with the class teacher. Important information about the day ahead is often shared with the class in the mornings. Your child may also miss the opportunity to socialise with their friends before settling down to a day of learning. Children arriving late into school often disrupt lessons, which can be embarrassing and upsetting for the child. ***Did you know that being 15 minutes late each morning means your child is missing the equivalent of 10 days off school per year?***
