

Class 2 homework – Thursday 22nd November 2018

We are beginning to practice songs for our Christmas performance and soon some children will have narration parts. Please help your children to learn these at home, thank you.

5 times table: Please keep practising your five times table and your ten times table.

Maths: Your homework this week is on time. The sheet will be stuck in your homework book if it was given in, otherwise you will be given the sheet. Please help your child with o'clock, half past, quarter to and quarter past.

Reading: Please remember to try to read **every day** for 10 minutes. At some point each week please ask an adult to write a small comment in your reading log to let me know how you are getting on at home.

Spellings: The spelling test will be on Wednesday.

Grasshoppers: second rule for adding the suffix **ing**. If a word ends in an **e** (e.g. shine) we drop the e before adding the suffix **ing** (shining). **Please help your child see the change from the root word to adding ing (shine – shining).**
