Provision for swimming at West Acton Primary School
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pupils in Years 3 and 4 attend swimming lessons for one term during each of the two academic years. • Each pupil has a total of 20 weeks of lessons over the two years. • Professional swimming instructors are employed to coach small groups of pupils according to their ability. • Pupils are assessed and grouped according to their different starting points. • Pupils are reassessed during the sessions and can move groups if they are making accelerated progress.

Impact on pupils of swimming lesson expenditure
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • In the academic year 2017-2018, 30% of children left Year 4 being able to swim the required standard of 25m. This is an improvement on the 2016-2017 academic year when 23% of children were proficient at the same level. • On average pupils make 0.5 steps of progress from their entry to their exit points over the two years. • All pupils understand the importance of health and safety in the water and confidently use water safety skills in and around water. • Pupils who are unable to swim the 25m make good progress during their swimming lessons. • There are a number of children in the 2017-2018 academic year who are very proficient swimmers and the swimming instructors have challenged them to learn different strokes and enter competitive swimming competitions.
