Prime Areas

The children have been learning all about how different people celebrate.

In PE, the children have been practising their nativity dances.

In Communication and Language, the children have been thinking about questions to ask each other about their birthdays or celebrations that they have been to.

Specific Areas

In literacy, the children are learning all about birthdays through the story of 'So much.' The children really enjoyed the accents that we put on to read the story. In phonics, the children are learning Phase 2 sounds. We recapped sounds learnt so far:

s, a, t, p, i, n, m, d, g, o, c, k, u, r, h, f, f
f, l, ll, s, ss and we are writing cvc words eg

pin, dog, cat. Please practise to write words with these sounds and others that they may know. **Please ensure that your children's reading record book is in their book bag every day as we need to record when your child has read.**

In maths the children have been learning about addition and how to find missing numbers and count larger totals. In the outside area the children have really enjoyed combining our candles (skittles) onto our cake!
