



Proposed admission arrangements for the academies part of SHINE Multi Academy Trust for September 2020 – 2021

Consultation

SHINE Multi-Academy Trust (SHINE) is consulting on the admission arrangements for pupils who will be starting school for the first time in the autumn term 2020 or changing from one school to another between September 2020 and July 2021.

In accordance with the requirements of the School Admissions Code, we must consult on our arrangements for a full six-week period. The statutory consultation period for SHINE and its academies will run from:

Monday, 26 November 2018 until Monday, 14 January 2019.

Summary of changes to arrangements

Ranskill Primary School (annex A)

The only changes to the arrangements from those determined for the 2019/2020 academic year are to amend:

1. The process of application for delayed entry has been clarified - paragraph 2.5.
2. Oversubscription criteria 2 and 4 to give clarity as to when a child is considered to have a sibling at Ranskill Primary School - paragraph 3.1.
3. The definition of parent has been explained - paragraph 3.2.
4. The definition of siblings to include stepbrother or stepsister where two children are related by a parent's civil partnership as well as by a parent's marriage - paragraph 3.2.
5. In the event of oversubscription, the measurement of distance has been defined - paragraph 4.1.
6. The term place of residence has been clarified - paragraph 5.2.

7. To avoid misinterpretation with paragraph 4 it has been determined '7.1 When one child of a multiple birth can be admitted, the other child/children will also be admitted' is no longer required and has been deleted.
8. The process for late applications has been updated - paragraph 8.1 and sub paragraphs 8.1.1 to 8.1.3.
9. The procedures to support waiting lists has been clarified - paragraph 9.1 to 9.4.
10. In year admissions have been defined - paragraph 12.1 to 12.4.

No further changes to the arrangements are proposed.

Scotholme Primary and Nursery School (annex B)

The only changes to the arrangements from those determined for the 2019/2020 academic year are to amend:

1. Applications for places in reception for summer born children has been clarified - paragraph 2.2.
2. In the event of oversubscription, the measurement of distance has been defined - paragraph 6.1.
3. Oversubscription criteria 2 and 4 to give clarity as to when a child is considered to have a sibling at Scotholme Primary and Nursery School - paragraph 6.2.
4. Acceptance of a place had been defined - paragraph 7.1.
5. The definition of siblings to include stepbrother or stepsister where two children are related by a parent's civil partnership as well as by a parent's marriage - paragraph 10.2.1.

No further changes to the arrangements are proposed.

Whitemoor Academy (annex C)

The only changes to the arrangements from those determined for the 2019/2020 academic year are to amend:

1. Applications for places in reception for summer born children has been clarified - paragraph 2.2.
2. In the event of oversubscription, the measurement of distance has been defined - paragraph 6.1.



3. Oversubscription criteria 2 and 4 to give clarity as to when a child is considered to have a sibling at Whitemoor Academy - paragraph 6.2.
4. Acceptance of a place had been defined - paragraph 7.1.
5. The definition of siblings to include stepbrother or stepsister where two children are related by a parent's civil partnership as well as by a parent's marriage - paragraph 10.2.1.

No further changes to the arrangements are proposed.

Ironville and Codnor Park Primary School

For 2020/2021 there are no changes to the admission arrangements - Ironville and Codnor Park Primary School will be following Derbyshire County Council's admission arrangements for community and controlled schools for the academic year 2020/2021.
