KS2 Lunchtime Coach	£3500	KS2 children benefit from the structured activities organised by the AllKidsCan coaches; the children look forward to their turn with the coach. Use of the coaches will be reviewed at Christmas and again at February half-term; once the Play Leaders scheme is completed and the children are trained, they should be able to run lunchtime sessions.
Charlton Athletic Partnership	£4000	The Charlton Athletic Partnership allows us access to all of the tournaments they run, usually Spring 2 and the Summer term. On top of this, we receive 8 hours of CPD for staff; 2 CACT coaches for a day, as well as an after school club coach; and a range of other benefits (see below). The 2 coaches have already begun to make an impact in the children's learning, notably in Year 4 for maths and English and in Year 2, where they deliver afternoon PE sessions.
New playground/PE equipment	£8000	The PE and playground equipment (both KS1 and KS2) is in need of updating and refreshing; the equipment available for use at lunchtimes is especially lacking). The spending in this area will contribute to a wider and more varied PE curriculum for our children, including new hockey sticks, yoga mats and tennis/badminton nets, in turn contributing to the healthy lifestyles we are looking to foster within the school.
After School Sports Clubs	£3000	The After School Clubs are now run by qualified coaches, both from the Charlton Athletic Community Trust and AllKidsCan. This provides our students with a

		very enjoyable experience, and our parents with the security of knowing their children are being coached by qualified professionals. This also helps contribute to our students' healthier lifestyles.
Transportation to sporting activities, i.e. horse riding, tournaments etc	£3000	The horse-riding attended y some of our SEND students has been a great success in the past, and transportation to this allows the program to continue with the new group of students. Transportation to tournaments and other sporting events will raise the profile of sport within the school; the children's enjoyment of sport; as well as the school's profile.
