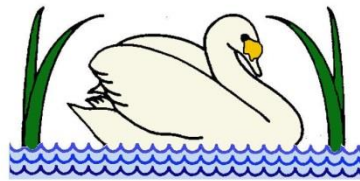

Use capital letters for I and some proper nouns.

Begin to use question marks and exclamation marks.

Use adjectives to describe.

Check writing makes sense and make simple changes.

Spell words with previously taught phonemes correctly.

Spell common exception words.

Reading

Various texts and genres will be read throughout the year, incorporating the following learning objectives:

Read all 40+ phonemes correctly.

Read common exception words.

Read words with contractions and suffixes.

Recite simple poems.

Make simple predictions and inferences.

Discuss word meanings.

Check reading makes sense and self-corrects.

Listen to and discuss a wide range of poetry, fiction and non-fiction texts.

Assessment
