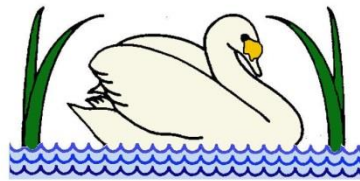


Year 3 Curriculum

Reading

Various texts and genres will be read throughout the year, incorporating the following learning objectives:

Decode and read age-appropriate texts fluently.

Listen to and discuss a wide range of poetry, fiction and non-fiction texts.

Read aloud with expression, intonation and action.

Recognise different forms of poetry.

Discuss word meanings.

Retrieve information from a non-fiction text.

Use a dictionary to check the meaning of words.

Make predictions and inferences.

Check reading makes sense and self-corrects.

Assessment
