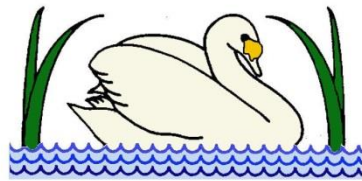

Various texts and genres will be taught throughout the year, incorporating the following learning objectives:

Write simple, compound and complex sentences.

Write expanded phrases and clauses for different effects.

Use a range of verb forms.

Use correct tense.

Use a range of punctuation – brackets, dashes, commas, hyphens, bullet points, semi-colons and colons.

Use paragraphs.

Show writer or character's viewpoint.

Use imaginative and well-chosen word choices and phrases.

Check writing makes sense and make changes.

Spell Year 6 statutory spellings.

Reading

Various texts and genres will be read throughout the year, incorporating the following learning objectives:

Decode and read age-appropriate texts fluently.

Listen to and discuss a wide range of poetry, fiction and non-fiction texts.

Read aloud with expression, intonation and action.

Recognise different forms of poetry.

Asks questions about texts.

Distinguishes between fact and opinion.

Discuss word meanings.

Justify predictions and inferences.

Identify and summaries ideas from paragraphs.

Assessment
